### **RIVER RALLY** GROUP AGREEMENTS

In addition to our COVID Safety Guidelines, which every River Rally attendee committed to upon registration, we encourage everyone to adhere to the following group agreements. These group agreements will act as guide stars for how we will keep ourselves and this community safe, respected, and supported over our five days together.

#### **Respect boundaries.**

We will ask for consent before physically greeting others (e.g. handshakes or hugs). Pay attention to lanyard colors, which disclose comfort levels. Red means please keep an appropriate distance!

#### Practice inclusivity.

River Rally is a space where all identities are welcome. We will create and maintain a welcoming and respectful space for all by acknowledging attendees' personal pronouns as displayed on their badge. We will be mindful of calling people in and kindly reminding our peers of others' correct pronouns if misgendering occurs.

### Test for COVID-19 at the first sign of symptoms.

#### Wear a well-fitting mask.
