He knows the network and the organization, having led The River Alliance of Wisconsin and recently serving on the River Network Board of Directors. Currently Midwest Director of Freshwater Policy for The Nature Conservancy, Raj's environmental background spans grassroots advocacy, corporate engagement, and online technology.
